

CORPORATE/SOCIAL EVENTS ENTERTAINMENT SERVICES AGREEMENT 2007

1. Entertainment Services. The Customer hereby employs the Contractor to perform the following services in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this agreement. The Contractor will provide musical entertainment consisting of :

String Quartet * One hour \$500__ Each additional hour \$200__
Violin Duo * One hour \$300____ Each additional hour \$150__

The Contractor's work will be performed in a commercially reasonable manner according to the stated wishes of the Customer. Note: **Any location outside Franklin County will be charged a standard mileage rate of .50 cents/mile.**

2. Payment to Contractor. The Customer agrees to pay the Contractor \$_____ for the services provided. The Customer also agrees to pay a **\$100 non-refundable deposit**, which will be applied towards final payment, receipt of which is acknowledged by the Contractor upon the execution of this agreement. This deposit is non-refundable in that it covers booking and other administrative expenses and is intended to partially compensate the Contractor in the event of a cancellation. **The Customer agrees to pay the Contractor's bill in full seven (7) business days prior to the event. Contractor has the right to cancel services if final payment is not recieved. _____(initial)**

3. Cancellation. Either party may cancel this agreement by giving 30 days advance notice to the other. Notice to the Customer shall be given to (name & phone #) _____. Notice to the Contractor shall be given to **Gail Stadelman (614) 457-5854**. In the event of a timely cancellation by the Customer, the Contractor will refund any money paid by the Customer to the Contractor other than the \$100 non-refundable deposit. In the event that the contractor is unable to perform due to injury, or extreme illness, then every effort will be made to find alternative musicians in order to fulfill the said agreement, or refund all monies paid.

4. Excused Performance. If the Contractor is unable to perform under this agreement due to circumstances beyond the Contractor's control, such as fire, flood, blizzard, other Act of God, military action, war, insurrection, riot, strike, civil disturbance, or travel restrictions imposed by a governmental authority, the Contractor will be released from any and all liability under this agreement

***For all outdoor events please note that direct sunlight will damage our instruments, and therefore some type of shade must be provided. Also, if severe temperatures(above 95F or below 65F), in the Contractor's reasonable judgment, would damage our instruments if used outdoors, the Customer must provide alternate indoor arrangements. If no alternate indoor arrangement are made, the Contractor will be released from any and all liability under this agreement.**
